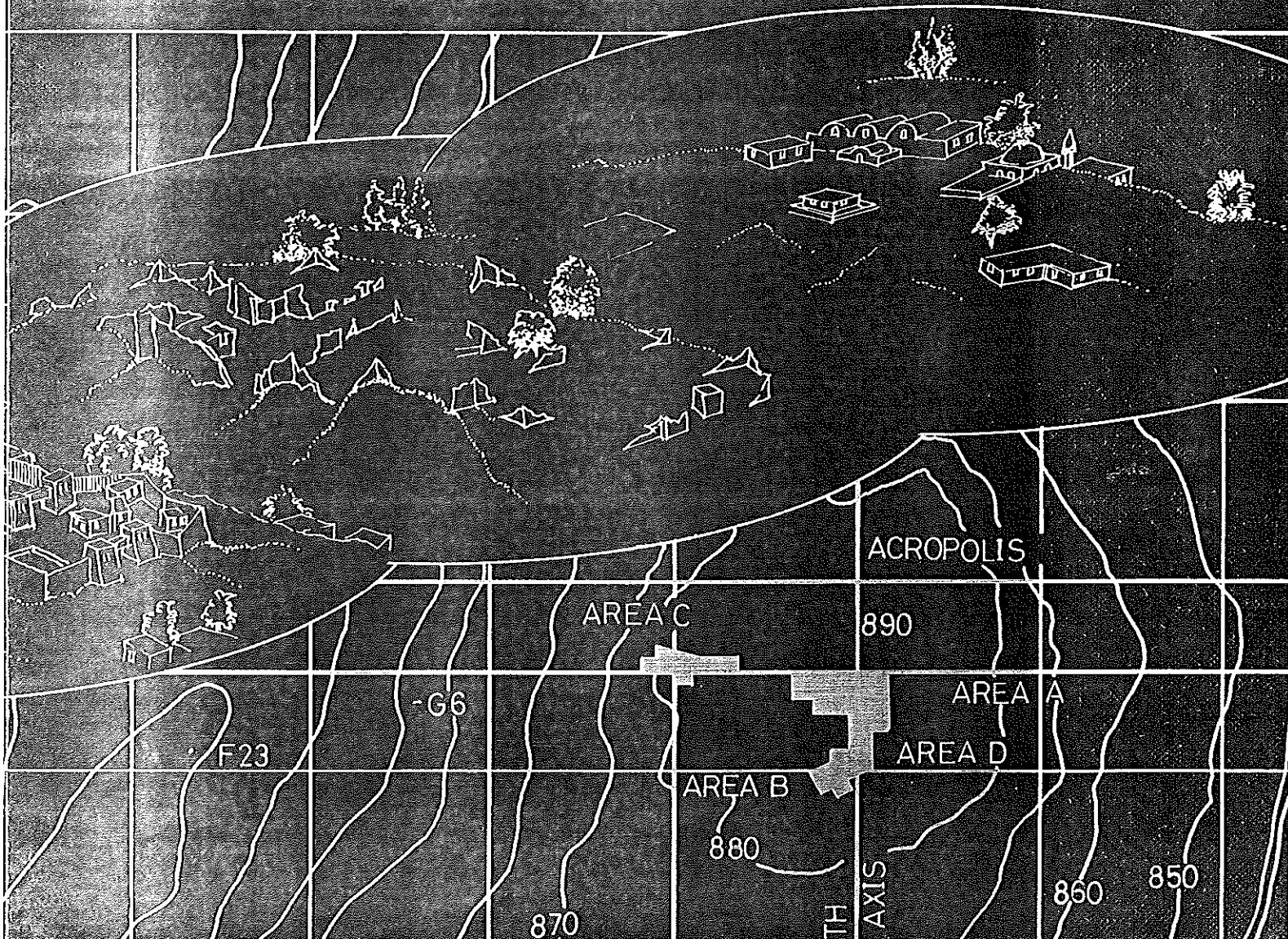

Overview of the Hesban Final Publication Series

Editor's Note: When completed, the Hesban Final Publication Series will consist of 14 volumes in five parts.

The first part (Hesban 1) offers an integrative account of cultural changes at Hesban and vicinity from a food systems perspective.

The second part (Hesban 2-4) contains background studies of Hesban's local environment, history from literary sources, and present-day inhabitants.

The third part (Hesban 5-9) discusses the archaeological survey of the Hesban region with stratigraphy interpretation from the Iron Age, Hellenistic-Roman, Byzantine-Early Islamic, and Ayyubid-Mamluk periods.

The fourth part (Hesban 10-13) presents the results of specialists' studies of the Roman-Byzantine cemetery, the pottery, the objects, and the animal remains.

The fifth part (Hesban 14) evaluates the implications of all of the above studies for our understanding of biblical and ancient Near Eastern history. The volumes are being made available as work on the various manuscripts is completed and not necessarily in numerical order.

Hesban 1: Sedentarization and Nomadization *Øystein Sakala LaBianca (Andrews University)*

This volume pulls together the various lines of evidence presented in the other 13 volumes to reconstruct and explain the cultural changes which have taken place over the past 3,500 years at Hesban and vicinity. To this end, the volume employs the food system concept and related theoretical constructs, such as sedentarization and nomadization, upon which our understanding of cultural change at Hesban pivots.

A. D. 630 to 1900; Intensification and Abatement: Summary and Reflections; Appendix A: Bibliography of Hesban-Related Scholarly Publications; Appendix B: Overview of the Hesban Final Publication Series; Appendix C: Sponsors and Participants of the Heshbon Expedition; Arabic Summary; Author Index; General Index. Includes 47 figures, 83 plates, and 16 tables. 350 pages.

Hesban 2: Environmental Foundations

Edited by Øystein Sakala LaBianca (Andrews University) and Larry Lacelle (British Columbia Ministry of Environment)

An introduction to the climate and landscape to which successive generations of Hesbanites have had to adapt.

Hesban 3: Historical Foundations

Edited by Lawrence T. Geraty (Atlantic Union College) and Leona G. Running (Andrews University)

Volume 3 presents an analysis of Old Testament, Egyptian, Greek, Arab, and European literary references to Tell Hesban and its surrounding region.

Hesban 4: Ethnoarchaeological Foundations

Volume 4 tells, from the perspective of an archaeologist-turned-ethnographer, how the people of Hesban and vicinity gradually converted from wandering pastoralists to villagers and townsmen over the past 150 years.

Hesban 5: Archaeological Survey of the Hesban Region

Robert D. Ibach, Jr. (Dallas Theological Seminary)

This volume offers systematic descriptions, including numerous maps and photographs, of the 148 archaeological sites visited by the expedition's regional survey team within a 10-km radius of Tell Hesban.

Hesban 6: Iron Age Strata

This volume presents a layer-by-layer account, including numerous plans and photographs, of the discoveries made in Tell Hesban's four Iron Age strata (12th to 5th centuries B.C.). These discoveries are interpreted in the light of contemporary natural, cultural, and historical events.

Hesban 7: Hellenistic and Roman Strata

These discoveries are interpreted in the light of contemporary natural, cultural, and historical events.

Hesban 8: Byzantine and Early Islamic Strata

J. Bjørnar Storfjell (Andrews University)

Volume 8 presents a layer-by-layer account, with numerous plans and photographs, of the discoveries made in Tell Hesban's six Byzantine and Early Islamic strata (4th to the 10th centuries A.D.). These discoveries are interpreted in the light of contemporary natural, cultural, and historical events.

Hesban 9: Ayyubid-Mamluk Strata

Bert de Vries (Calvin College)

The discoveries of Tell Hesban's four Ayyubid-Mamluk strata (12th to the 15th centuries A.D.) are presented in a layer-by-layer account, including numerous plans and photographs. These discoveries are interpreted in the light of contemporary natural, cultural, and historical events.

Hesban 10: The Necropolis of Heshbon

Edited by Øystein Sakala LaBianca (Andrews University) and Lawrence T. Geraty (Atlantic Union College)

Volume 10 offers a tomb-by-tomb account, with plans and photographs, of the 41 Roman and Byzantine tombs excavated in the vicinity of Hesban's cemetery.

Volume 12 presents in text and numerous drawings and photographs studies of the large quantity of ivory, stone, iron, glass, and jewelry objects uncovered at Tell Hesban and the nearby cemetery.

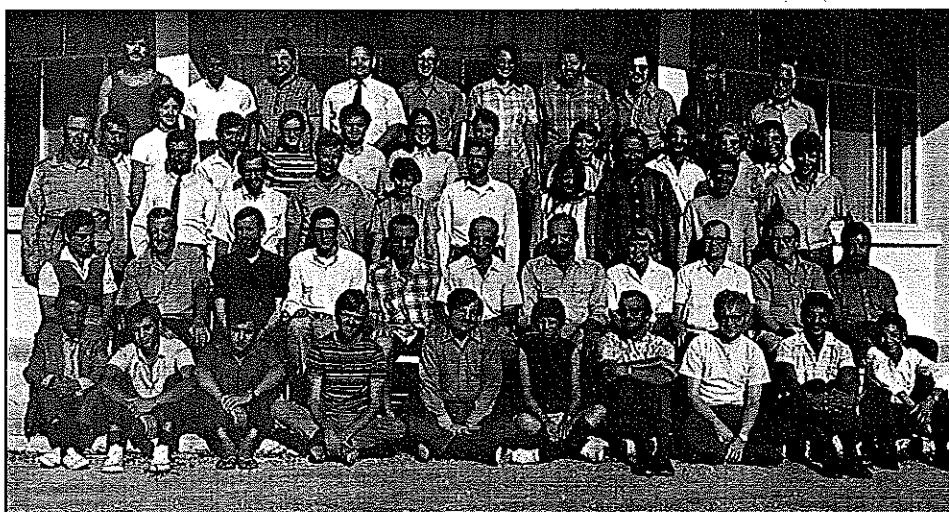

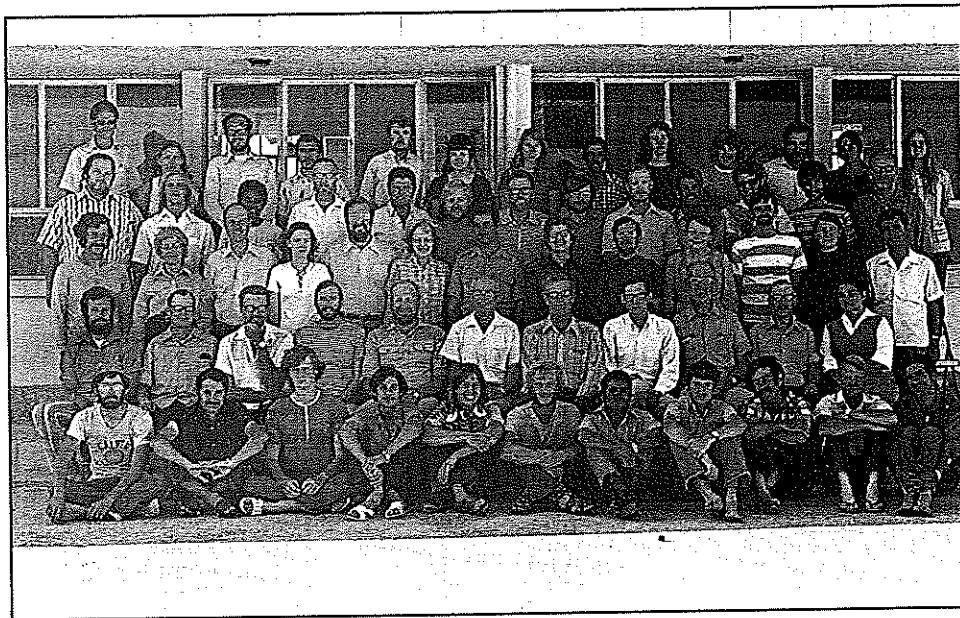
